

Wayne County Airport Authority - Airport System Plan

A System Plan is being prepared in parallel with master plans for Detroit Metro and Willow Run airports



- 7. Provide flexibility to adapt to changing circumstances





Forecast Methodology and Approach




Forecast Passengers

Forecast Aircraft Operations






Different from the 2009 Ultimate Master Plan, a new runway will not be needed in the 20 year planning horizon

The airport is in good condition, well maintained, and well positioned to accommodate future activity












Key Findings to Date: Passenger Terminals


