Permit Request: Off-Airport Rental Car

If approved, an Operator Permit will be granted in accordance with the terms of the Form of Agreement (FOA) provided following receipt of a completed business case based on this form.

Business Case:

In order for the Authority to determine suitability for operations at DTW, the requesting company (Permittee) must demonstrate both the quality of services to be provided and the stability of the company.

Approval Process:

If all documentation is in order and the permit is approved, WCAA must complete a walk-through of the off-airport location to verify all terms of the permit are in place prior to commencement of operations at the airport. This includes verification of compliance with all FAA and Airport directives while on airport property.
