Airport Authority to Host Public Information Workshop on Detroit Metro Airport Master Plan --Public participation encouraged

The Wayne County Airport Authority and aviation consultant, Jacobsen/Daniels Associates, will host a public information workshop regarding future development plans for Detroit Metropolitan Wayne County Airport (DTW) on Wednesday, November 7, 2007, from 5:00 - 7:00 p.m. at the Metropolitan Hotel, 31500 Wick Road, Romulus, Michigan.

This workshop will provide the public with an opportunity to learn about the Airport Authority's aviation-related development needs over the next twenty years. Public input on the development options in and around Detroit Metro Airport will be welcomed.

The workshop will be conducted in an 'open-house' format, allowing the public to come by at any point during the two-hour session. There will be no formal presentation; participants will have the opportunity to review airport development plans and discuss them one-on-one with airport planners and other key decision-makers.

The workshop is part of the Airport Authority's ongoing Public Coordination Program, which has engaged the public in each stage of the airport's planning process.
