## **Executive Ficano names community leaders to Airport Authority Board**

**Wayne County** – Wayne County Executive Robert A. Ficano has appointed two respected community leaders to the Wayne County Airport Authority Board.

Samuel A. Nouhan and Renee C. Pipis will both serve six-year terms beginning January 2009.
