Airport customers should plan ahead for road construction *--Lane restrictions could slow the trip*

Boarding pass? Check. Photo ID? Check. Extra socks? Check. Alternate route to the airport? Not a bad thing to have in your hip pocket.

Motorists headed to Detroit Metropolitan Airport will want to give themselves some extra time to negotiate road construction projects underway in the vicinity of the airport. Currently, bridge work on both north and southbound I-275 has caused lane restrictions and traffic slow-downs. More airport-area road work is planned in the months ahead.
